



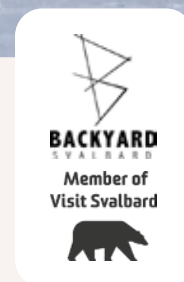

The fjords of Svalbard are nature's gift to ski fanatics: they are the ultimate place to go Ski & Sail. Surrounded by majestic nature, where mountains meet the sea, you now have the chance to join our guides and find untouched slopes waiting for you... Remote places you can only reach by boat!

Ski and sail



Your sailing basecamp will take you to fresh pow. With two guides and ten guests, the guides can split the group and adapt the challenge to your goals and abilities. We'll make sure you'll push yourself to make great memories. Back on board you can enjoy your hot, private shower, relax and enjoy nature and wonderful food in great company.

Explore nature



Our sturdy expedition Zodiacs take you ashore, so close to the water you are totally immersed in the Arctic. You will still see frozen seascapes, floating ice and wildlife in their natural habitat - enjoy the stunning scenery while preparing for your climb and descend!



High quality sailing expedition ship

Ocean Sherpa's beautiful rigging might come across as traditional, but is fine-tuned to perfection. The sails are easily handled so even unexperienced guests can take an active part in the handling of the ship. In addition to the fore-and-aft sail setup Ocean Sherpa has three square rigged sails, enabling her to sail in traditional style, like the old day explorers.

Comfortable accommodation

The spacious deck gives plenty of seating to enjoy the view and spot wildlife, a heated doghouse offers shelter when needed. The crow's nest in the mast and the accessible jib net offer great opportunities for photography and observing maritime fauna.

The deckhouse holds an inviting saloon with a bar and a panoramic view. You can relax or enjoy a meal while still observing the wonders around you.

Expert insulation, heating and ventilation insure a comfortable climate on board. The practical double cabins equipped with shower and wash basin are situated below decks, every cabin has its own porthole and European sockets with 220 Volts.



Chef

The cook on board is a professional ship's cook or chef. He will provide a wide variety of meals, prepared in our professionally equipped galley.

Program

After landing in Svalbard Airport, your sailing adventure starts the next day in the afternoon with meeting the crew and settling into your cabin. After a light dinner and once sailing, we'll inform you about life aboard and the weekly program. We always take the weather and other factors into account, as well as the wishes and possibilities of our guests.

Day 1



Longyearbyen - Let go the lines

On the first voyage we head towards beautiful Isfjorden, a majestic fjord in Svalbard. Anchoring in Trygghamna, we're in position for the first day of skiing. The bay Trygghamna was given the name "Safe harbour" because of its calm and easy seas.

Day 2

First lines

With the starting point in Trygghamna and Ymerbukta we have plenty of options to put our first lines in the snow. Once back on board, you'll enjoy a fantastic meal before heading towards St. Johns fjord.

Today's mountains: Protektorfjellet or Daudmannen or Karlstادتoppen





Day 3

Out of reach

You'll wake up to the beautiful scenery of St. Johns fjord - here the treasures are hidden. They say that there's gold somewhere in St. Johns'.... go out and get it!

Today's mountains: Lowsowfjella, Konowfjellet, Holmesletfjellet or Gunnar Knudsenfjella.



Day 4 & 5

Krossfjorden

The destination for these two days is Krossfjorden. You are now 79 degrees north, not far away from Kings Bay and Ny-Ålesund. This is the northernmost place of this tour, so make sure to fully enjoy the moment and take in this once-in-a-lifetime experience!

Today's mountains: Amfifjellet, Shottfjellet, Midtryggen, Willeberget, or Nibba. We might also check out Nielsenfjellet in Kongsfjorden.



Day 6



Prins Karls Forland

This long island is shortly called “ the Foreland”, and is the westernmost island in the Svalbard archipelago. Probably the mountains that Willem Barentsz discovered first in 1594. He gave it the name “Spitsbergen” because of the pointy mountains. Enjoy the slopes!

Today’s mountains: Sesshøgda, Krokodillen, Alfred Larsentoppen, or Alexanderfjellet in Engelsbukta.

Day 7

Isfjorden

Isfjorden has countless skiing opportunities, and depending on the weather, your guide will take you to the best spots. Ski your heart out, as this is the last day of skiing!

Today’s mountains: St.Johnsfjorden or Ymerbukta.



Day 8

Disembark in Longyearbyen

After a full week at sea and in remote mountains, it’s time to return to civilization. Disembark the boat, explore the charming Longyearbyen, and catch your flight in the afternoon!
